NOTE:

- Admissions in Post Graduate Programmes (except MPT Course) will be offered on the basis of merit of all previous semesters except the final semester of the qualifying examination.
- However, it is compulsory to pass the last semester of Under Graduate course (qualifying examination) before the commencement of the first-semester exam of the PG program in which the candidate is admitted, otherwise his/her admission will be cancelled.
- The candidate will have to give an undertaking at the time of counselling/interview that, if he/she does not pass the final semester of Under Graduate Programmes on the basis of which the candidate has got admission, the seat allotted to such candidate will stand cancelled.
