

The new lateral entry-cum-admissions policy for admission to vacant seats in the teaching departments of Punjabi University, Patiala shall be as follows:

1. At the end of every academic year, details will be gathered in respect of seats, in various departments on the university Camps, the remain vacant or fall vacant on account of the students having left their studies midway after taking admission in postgraduate as well as in three-/four-/five-year courses. Under The new lateral entry-cum-admissions policy the vacant seats shall be filled after uploading their availability on the University portal, advertising of the seats and receipt of applications for the next academic year. This policy shall not be applicable to the courses in the Engineering Colleges in Punjabi University campus and to the students already admitted in Talwandi Sabo campus admitted in.
2. Under this policy the amount of fee for lateral entry-cum-migration shall be decided by the Dean Academic Affairs, the Dean of the Faculty and the Finance Officer.
3. The candidate seeking admission under this policy shall be required to have completed the first year of his studies of a postgraduate or three-/four-/five-year course in a recognised institution/university. The candidate's admission shall be allowed only after a scrutiny of the documents submitted by her/him.
4. The students getting admission under this policy shall be required to submit their applications along with the receipt of fee of Rupees 1000/- (for SC students, Rupees 700/-) deposited.
5. After the admission, the concerned department shall inform the students as well as the Controller (Examinations) how many deficient papers have to be cleared. A list to this effect shall be displayed.
6. The students shall be responsible for any dues/pending amount of fees pertaining to the institution he/she previously studied in before being admitted under this policy in the University.
7. The fee for every deficient paper (theory/practical) shall be Rupees 1500/-, which can be increased/decreased from time to time.
8. The fees payable by the students admitted under this policy shall be the same as are payable by the regular students already pursuing their studies.
9. Any dispute arising shall be resolved by the decision of a committee comprising the Dean Academic Affairs, the FO, the Head of the Department concerned and the Controller of Examinations. The decision of the committee shall be binding on all parties.
10. This policy shall come into effect from the academic year 2021-22 and shall be got approved from the Academic Council.
11. In the event of applicants being more than the number of seats available, the admission shall be on merit, the basis for which will be the percentage of marks obtained in the previous class.
12. The amount of fees to be charged under this policy is shown in the table of vacant seats.
