

## **Admission Criteria for preparing merit list for Admission in PG Programs**

- Admissions in Post Graduate programs (except MPT, Pharmacy, LL.M Courses) will be offered on the basis of merit of all previous semesters except the final semester of the qualifying examination.
- However, it is compulsory to pass the last semester of Under Graduate course (qualifying examination) before the commencement of the first-semester exam of the PG program in which the candidate is admitted, otherwise his/her admission will be cancelled.
- The candidate will have to give an undertaking at the time of counselling/interview that, if he/she do not pass the final semester of Under Graduate courses on the basis of which the candidate has got admission, the seat allotted to such candidate will stand cancelled. Note: After the counselling/ interview the Tentative Merit List/ Final Merit List / Seats Allotted & Waiting List will be displayed on the website <https://pupadmissions.ac.in> as per counselling schedule notified. The concerned candidate can check his/her status with regard to admission by using his/her own User ID and Password. The candidate who has been allotted a seat can deposit the tuition fee and other charges etc. online.
